Thank you for enquiring about Taekwon-Do training at Basingstoke.

Taekwon-Do is first and foremost an unarmed self-defence martial art. It also has the privilege of being one of the few real 'Martial Arts', the term Martial meaning – 'of the military'. The founder, who was a General in the Armed Forces of Korea, developed Taekwon-Do through the military academies in Korea.

There is emphasis placed upon developing various parts of the body to provide powerful defensive tools under attack and equally powerful offensive weapons to counter attack. Along with the physical training there is the introduction of courtesy and discipline required in an institute of learning.

We are privileged to have a pioneer Taekwon-Do Grand Master Rhee Ki Ha who lives in the UK as the founder of the association. He teaches regularly and all students are invited to train at special seminars.

At a local level the original Basingstoke school started in 1985 by my original instructor Grand Master Paul Cutler IX Dan.

Training is conducted in a disciplined but enthusiastic manner, encouraging participation of all students in a controlled but not forced training schedule inline with the curriculum of the United Kingdom Taekwon-Do Association and the International Taekwon-Do Federation.

Introduction and Information

When you are accepted as a Taekwon-Do student you will become a member of a national organisation with many thousand students in the UK.

The Instructor at Basingstoke is Mr Mike O'Neill 5th Dan. Mr O'Neill is a qualified ITF International Instructor, a registered member of the British Taekwon-Do Council and certified to teach children and vulnerable adults.

As with all sports there are certain expenses.

Annual School Membership Subscription

There is an initial registration fee of £35.00 (£20.00 per additional family member if joining at the same time) which includes the school registration and your training/grading record booklet and BTC insurance.

The annual renewal is £25 (£15.00 per additional family member if applying at the same time.

Training Fees

Monthly Training Fees: -

Children's Class (under 12) Training Times 6.40pm to 7.30pm
Cheque/Cash - £15.00 per month. Standing Order - £10.00 per month.

Adult's Class (over 12) Training Times 7.30pm to 9.00pm
Cheque/Cash - £25.00 per month. Standing Order - £20.00 per month.

Training Suit

A UKTA/ITF Taekwon-Do training suit will be required prior to taking any grading exam and currently cost approx. £35.00 for adult sizes (over 160cm) and £29.95 for junior sizes (100-150cm). They are complete with all badges and a white belt. Coloured belts are provided upon a successful grading but remain the property of the instructor.

New suits are available from www.taekwondo-supplies.com.

Second hand suits (if available) may be purchased from the instructor.

Safety Equipment

Students will require safety equipment in order to participate in free sparring in the class. This is part of the training syllabus from Yellow belt (8th grade). It is compulsory in competitions. Minimum safety equipment consists of hand and feet protectors. Juniors also require a head protector.

New equipment is available from www.taekwondo-supplies.com. You may purchase second hand safety equipment from the instructor subject to availability – check the website www.basingstoketkd.com.

Training Handbook

Students will get a beginners handout which will be sufficient to succeed the first and second grading.

A student's training handbook which covers everything that is required to take you from white belt to black belt is available from www.ukta.com.

Grading Examinations

Grading examinations are held on a regular basis and for most occasions are held locally. Junior students are always graded at Basingstoke unless alternative arrangements are especially made. From time to time training seminars and grading examinations are conducted by Grand Master Rhee Ki Ha 9th Dan or other Masters at local venues. Grading examinations are currently £20.00 for all students.

Training Seminars

There are regular special training seminars conducted by our Grand Master, other Masters and senior instructors on a regular basis. These are open to all students.

Adults have a two hour seminar at £20.00

Juniors (U12) have an hour seminar at £15.00

Competitions

There are national and local tournaments held throughout the year. These feature the main disciplines of patterns, sparring and breaking and are open to yellow belts (2nd grading) and above. Entry price varies according to the competition.

Demonstrations

There may be occasions when the school is asked to provide a demonstration at public events, this is an ideal opportunity to introduce Taekwon-Do and students of all levels are encouraged to participate in these demonstrations.

What to do next!

- 1) Complete the school membership application form.
- 2) Complete the training fees payment form.
- 3) Obtain 4 passport size photographs (write your name on the back of them).
Prints from a home colour printer on photo paper are fine.
- 4) Fill in the UKTA application form and stick one photograph in the required place.
- 5) Return the forms with your application fee (cheque made payable "Basingstoke Taekwon-Do". **and the other photographs** to the instructor.

Within a few weeks you should receive your licence and grade booklet, becoming a registered, licensed and insured Taekwon-Do student. The Instructor and students of the Basingstoke Taekwon-Do School welcome you to share and enjoy our martial art.
